## **ORDER FOR THE LORD'S DAY**

### **HOLY TRINITY**

**GATHERING MUSIC:** *This Trinity season, welcome to the joy and power of the Holy Spirit!*

*We use this time to make the transition between "getting here" and "being here". Take these few minutes to find the still, deep places within you, where God's Spirit, your breath, dwells. Relax the body; quiet the mind. Focus on breathing, feeling, being. Be receptive to your center—your reservoir of inner peace, strength, love. Be aware of being together in silence with others. Feel the spirit of the community.*

✠ **CALL TO WORSHIP** *adapted and read antiphonally, from **Genesis 1:1-5** and **John 1:1-5***

Right: In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. (Genesis...)

Left: **In the beginning was the Word,  
and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.** (John...)

Right: The earth was emptiness and nothingness, and darkness covered the face of the deep, and the Spirit of God brooded over the face of the waters.(G)

Left: **The Word was in the beginning with God. All things came into being through the Word, and without the Word was not one thing made that was made.** (J)

Right: Then God said, "Let there be light!" and there was light. (G)

Left: **In the Word was life, and the life was the light of the world.** (J)

All: **The light shines in the darkness,  
and the darkness has not overcome it.** (J)  
**Let us worship God!**
